Full road closure of Middletons Lane for traffic signal upgrade & construction of shared use path – A140 Holt Road, Norwich

Middletons Lane, Norwich will be closed to traffic from its junction with the A140 Holt Road to Bush Road from Monday 18 August until Friday 22 August 2025. For safety reasons this closure will be in place 24 hours per day.

To minimise disruption the closure has been programmed during summer holiday to avoid disruption to the nearby schools.

Access to and from properties within the closure will be maintained at all times via Reepham Road with staff on site to assist during working hours. Diversion routes for all other traffic are detailed below.

Diversion Routes:

Outbound (from the city) - Boundary Road, Reepham Road, Middletons Lane.

Inbound (towards the city) - A1270 Broadland Northway, Drayton Lane, Reepham Road, Middletons Lane.

Bus services

No bus services are affected by the Middletons Lane closure. However, please continue to check with your service provider for any alterations required as part of the ongoing project to extend the Yellow Pedalway route along the A140 Holt Road.

This work is being undertaken as part of the Yellow Pedalway scheme which will cost around £2.2m to deliver the current and subsequent phases. The works will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's infrastructure team and their contractors. This project is funded by [The Greater Norwich Growth Board](#) through the Infrastructure Investment Fund and money awarded to the County Council by the central government's Department for Transport (DfT).

The County Council thanks people for their patience while these improvements take

place. We understand any disruption on the roads is frustrating and are working with our contractor, Tarmac, throughout to minimise this as much as possible.
